- I. Call to Order & Roll:
 - a. Meeting called to order @ 6:17pm (we were unable to immediately secure internet access, additionally the room was not ready at 6pm; your understanding is appreciated for the delay). Our thanks to those who were able to attend virtually.

 - c. Zoom/Telephone: Adam Gray, Casey Slabe, Ken Kunkle, Allie Wilson, Kelly Dervis
- II. Items for Discussion
 - a. Review of events since last meeting – The PHA show was a success! Attendance was up 20% over prior years. Positive feedback was received about the hospitality, prizes, the National Rating, the revised schedule & how smoothly the show ran overall. The adult lead-line was a crowd pleaser; it was suggested to keep a “fun class” in the show and donate the entry fees to charity. Also discussed was the catering for next year; John will look into our options. Spencer will look into moving the pony divisions to earlier in the week in preparation for Pony Finals.
 - b. Review of Bylaws: See Attached. Book will be published on-line as soon as the updates are added.
 - c. Show Sanctioning – we have received sanctioning payments for 19 shows (2024) already and the forms have not yet been sent out! Forms will be mailed out ASAP.

V. Other Comments / Concerns:

- a. Suggestions are welcome on how to promote member involvement
- b. The following was submitted by a member who wishes to remain anonymous: *“Professionalism of local trainers (NOT current WPaPHA Trainers) is a concern of several families (other riders AND trainers speaking derogatorily at shows about the competitors). This has been an issue over the years, and needs to be addressed”*. We do agree that this is a problem, but do not have a solution. We intend to lead by example and hope that others will follow.
- c. As a follow up it was decided that the WPaPHA will not tolerate rude or demeaning behavior toward our members or volunteers. Any member who cannot conduct themselves appropriately will have their membership suspended and if appropriate be reported as required by USEF Safe Sport Guidelines.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:30PM

11/06/2023 Changes to WPaPHA Rule Book, made at 11/06/2023 open meeting:

- The term “Professional” was defined (taken from National PHA)
- In regards to voting, financial aid & points: All members, including former board members must be in good standing (ie. Current year dues have been paid). Reminder notices will not be mailed out to individuals.
- The USEF suspension list will now be included in the WPaPHA by-laws
- Open & restricted Jumper division heights now mirror USEF
- Hunter/Eq Jump heights were aligned with USEF
- Guidelines were added for trophies
- WPaPHA no longer requires 3 entries to pin in any class for points to accrue. Now, if show management runs a class, it will count for points. The WPaPHA will use the “24+” entries for determining points
- Breeding and Best Young Horse divisions were updated
- Points calculations were changed to provide the same points regardless of the show’s rating. The points table is based on the number of entries.
- Reference to former USEF ratings were updated
- Beginner, Limit, and Low Intermediate Rider are listed under the High Score Honors Section

The rule book also includes the updates made at the 2022 rules change meeting, including:

- Professional status is preferred for all board members, but if no professional is nominated or willing, a non-pro can sit on the board
