The first day of JHF, the classic day, came and I was super excited because Tom was so relaxed and loved the ring, so I felt super confident and ready to go. We had a super trip and ended up 20th out of 50 horses on the first day. The flatting day was on Saturday and it was probably the best ive ever flatted Tom, he felt very responsive and super. The

handy day was my personal favorite on Sunday. I was super excited about the course, it was open and had lots of room to be handy and really show off your horse. I had a really good school, before I went in the ring, I had a super nice pep talk and at that point I was ready to go. Tom shines in the handy rounds and he was so confident and we had a lovely trip resulting in 12th place out of a very large group of extremely nice horses and talented riders. We finished the weekend out by earning 15th overall at my very first Junior Hunter Final experience. I could not have asked for a better horse to carry me through the week or a better trainer cheering me on and constantly wishing for the best for me.
